Description: (Closed to motorized vehicles).

This trail travels through a clear cut area with an abundance of huckleberries and wildflowers that make a colorful display in mid summer. Shellrock Lake offers good fishing and several dispersed campsites along the east shore. Water and toilet facilities are not available at the trail parking area, but Hideaway Lake ampground is approximately 1/2 mile away. A trail of about one mile follows around the east side of the Lake and connects with the Rock Lakes basin near Frasier Turnaround. You may make a loop by following rails #517 and 512.

Frail Access:

The Trailhead is located on FS road 5830-190. Follow Hwy. 224 south from Estacada for 26 1/2 miles to 'S road 57, then 7 miles to FS road 58 for 3 miles to road 5830. Follow 5330 approximately 4 miles to he Hideaway Lake turnoff. The trail begins in Hideaway Lake Campground, or may be picked up at the parking area on road 5830, about 1/2 mile past the Hideaway Lake turnoff.

Crail Mileage Log:

- From the campground, the trail goes north up toward road 5830. 0.0
- Cross road 5830 and pick up trail going north from the parking area. 0.5
- 1.0 Trail passes out of open area and enters old growth forest.
- Trail reaches Shellrock Lake. 1.5
