PYRAMID LAKE #727

Recommended Season: June to November



Length: 0.2 miles Use: Light
Elevation: 3760' to 4000' Difficulty: Moderate
USGS Map: High Rock S.W.

Description: (*Closed to motorized vehicles*).

This trail is moderately challenging as it climbs uphill from the road to the lake. There are dispersed camping sites near the lake. Horses are allowed, but not recommended because of the short distance to the lake. The lake is usually quiet and there are fishing and picnicing opportunities. No facilities are provided. Bring your own drinking water.

Trail Access:

The Trailhead is located on FS road 5800-140. Follow Hwy. 224 south from Estacada for 26 1/2 miles to FS road 57, then 7 miles to FS road 58 for 5 miles to the 140 spur. The road crosses a dry creek bed and the last part of the road is very rough.

Trail Mileage Log:

- 0.0 From the road, the trail goes south up toward Pyramid Lake.
- 0.2 Trail ends at the lake.
