Description:

From west to east trail gradually ascends through mature sub-alpine forest passing a meadow and a viewpoint. A branch trail leads to an awesome viewpoint overlooking the heart of Clackamas country. A short, steep descent to FS Rd 5830 at the east end of the trail. Connects at this point with Cottonwood Meadows Trail 705.

Trail Access:

Follow Hwy. 224 south from Estacada for 26 miles to FS Rd 4631 (Ripplebrook Guard Station), then 2 miles to FS Rd 4635 for 7 ½ miles to the 140 spur, then 2 miles to the 146 spur. Trailhead is on the left about 1/4 mile.
