## COTTONWOOD MEADOWS #705

Recommended Season: June to November



Length: 1.0 miles                      Use: Light  
Elevation: 3200' to 3900'            Difficulty: More Difficult  
USGS Map: High Rock S.W.

### Description: (*Closed to motorized vehicles*).

This trail is moderately challenging requiring some physical stamina. The trail goes through mature forest with plenty of large game. Good opportunity for hunters. No camping available. No mt. bikes allowed, horses and hikers only. Now known as the Cottonwood Meadows trail, it was the old Cot Creek trail. The Cot Creek trail used to be the main route down to the Oak Grove fork of the Clackamas. The tread is still discernible down to road 4635-120.

### Trail Access:


The Trailhead is located on FS road 5830. Follow Hwy. 224 south from Estacada for 26 1/2 miles to FS road 57, then 7 miles to FS road 58 for 3 miles to road 5830. The trailhead parking area is just beyond the 230 spur. No toilet facilities or water.

### Trail Mileage Log:

0.0 From the road, the trail goes south through meadows.  
Trail ends at FS road 5830-260.
