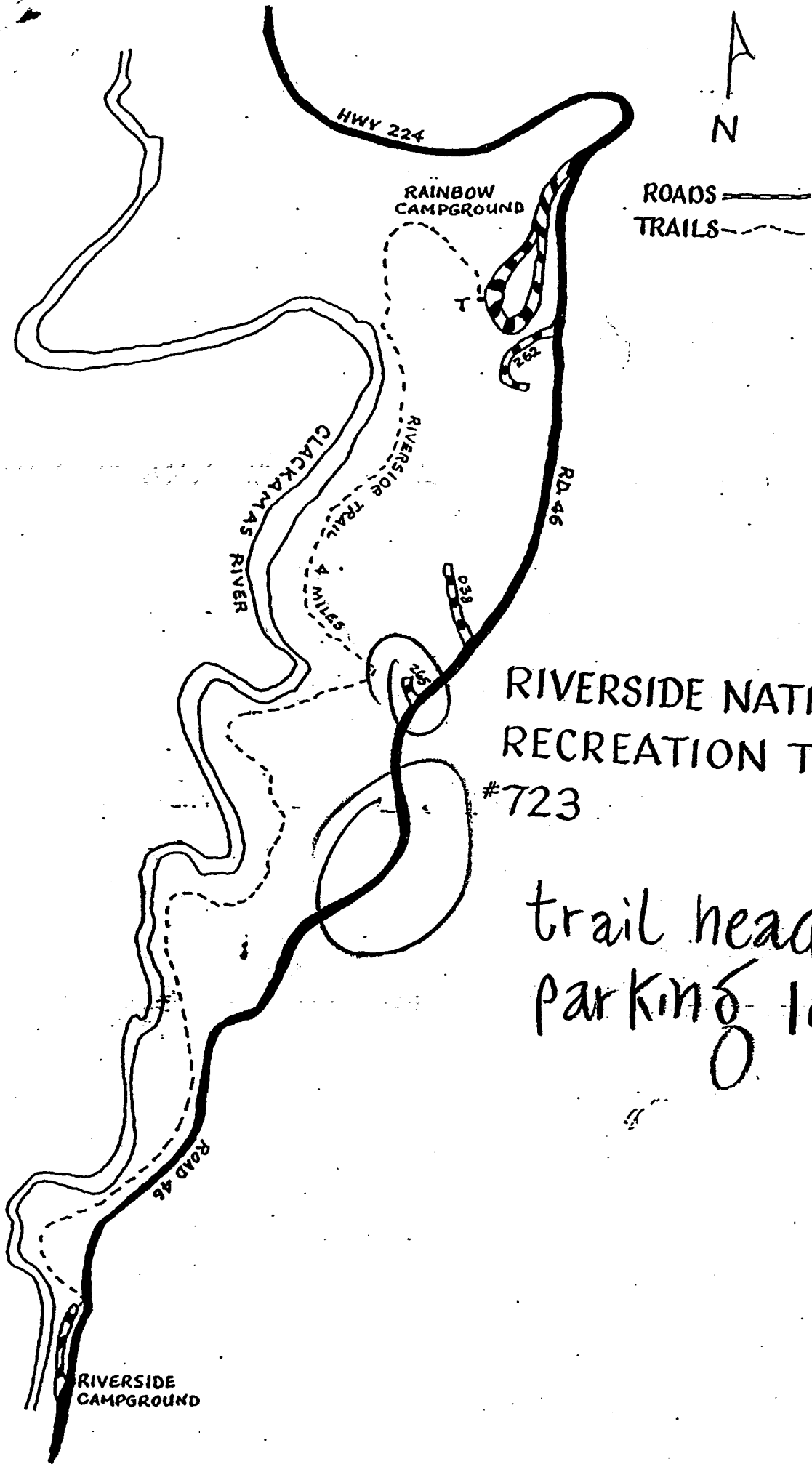

The Riverside National Recreation Trail has been designated by the Secretary of Agriculture under the National Trail Systems Act because of its outstanding scenic qualities and accessibility to urban areas. The trail weaves along the Clackamas River, affording the visitor many views of the river, as well as a chance to walk through some old growth. The trail is generally level, however the occasional fairly steep grades classify this as a moderately difficult trail. The trail runs between Rainbow and Ripple brook Campgrounds
