

DOUBLE PEAKS TRAIL 735

Recommended Season: June to November

Length: 0.8 Mile
Elevation: 5400' to 6000'

Use: Light
Difficulty: Difficult

USGS Map: Deleted – Use Olallie Scenic Area Map or older USGS Topo

Description:

This short but sweet trail leaves the Skyline Trail at Cigar Lake, skirts the lake along its south shore and then heads left towards the flanks of Double Peaks. The trail quickly begins an exceptionally steep no kidding ascent. Trail reaches a bench, levels off, and circles around to north side. It then continues up to the ridge between the peaks.

There are abundant opportunities for shade and views on the way up.

A fun place.

May need to wait until July to be free of snow. No water.

Trail access:

Trail begins at the Skyline Trail (PCT 2000) beside Cigar Lake. Departs west towards the lake at a pile of rocks. No sign at this time.

Trail Mileage Log:

- 0.0 Depart Skyline Trail
- 0.1 Leave shore of Cigar Lake
- 0.2 Begin ascent
- 0.8 Arrive ridge top
